Section 5.2 Capacity Expansion - The fee for Capacity Expansion is \$ 10,200.00. This fee includes **Capacity Expansion** to the District and the actual Service Connection.

Section 5.3 Broken Lock/Tampering - A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for any broken lock placed on a meter by the District, and not to be removed by anyone other than District personnel, if such lock is tampered with and damaged.

SECTION 5.4 Dishonored Check Fee - If water charges and/or fees are paid to the District by check and the bank does not honor check, a charge of \$30.00 will be levied to the account and the District may proceed with the discontinuance of service without further notice.
